

Stabling Notes:

Stabling assignments will be posted on Wed on Start Box link along with the ride times @ <http://eventingscores.com/eventsr/sgf/ht0910/>. However I wanted to make a few notes concerning stabling which can't go on the link. After a very slow start we ended up with more requests for stabling than we have stalls. On grounds stabling were assigned on a 'first come basis' and those who entered late were assigned off grounds stalls. Off grounds stabling is at two sites with nice permanent stalls. Please refer to the Google map and directions at the 'directions' tab on the website.

Below are additional notes for those who are stabled on grounds which will allow you to plan better for the weekend

On Grounds Stabling Notes:

- Check the stabling area maps to help you locate you stall(s)
- The driveway is ONE WAY, incoming traffic has priority. The drive belongs to our neighbors please DO NOT drive in their hay field!!
- Parking WILL be very tight, please park your trailers as close as possible and following the instructions of the parking attendant
- When you unhook please do not take up another parking spot with your truck
- Because parking will be tight **all cars** MUST park in the pasture facing the barn
- Stalls 59 – 70 NEED stall guards and do not have lights, please plan accordingly
- Lights are run off a generator and will be turned off @ 11:00PM and will be turned back on @ 6:30AM
- We ran out of time and didn't get a chance to improve the stall gates. If you have trouble opening the gate; pick it up in the middle.
- We hope you enjoy the new wash racks, please keep them clean by placing manure in the muck bucket
- If stalls are left STRIPPED your stall cleaning deposit check will be destroyed
- For the first time we will be leaving the driveway open during dressage, please use caution when going down the drive so you don't disturb horses doing tests in ring 2 (closest to the drive)

Access to the Dressage warm up:

- Please stay off the cross country course.
 - On Fri. you can access the dressage warm up by going between the two arenas
 - On Sat. horses will access the dressage warm up via the drive. Again please be courteous to those doing their test
 - Spectators, especially if you have children or dogs in tow, will access the dressage warm up through the cross country course to limit traffic on the drive

There is additional warm up to the south of the stabling area and if necessary could be used for additional parking
