### Stone Gate Farm Facilities:

- 111 acre farm is the site of 2 recognized Events, Mini Trials, Hunter Paces and more
- 2 sand standard size dressage arenas
- 1 large *new* all weather show jumping arena
- Large turf area with measured tracks – includes xc & steeplechase fences
- Cross country courses from Starter – Prelim
- 70 permanent stalls
- One small pasture & paddock available to camp horses (sign up sheet will be posted daily)
- Rustic bunk house and shower

### Camp Fees:

- \$600 if received by March 1
- \$650 if received by May 1
- \$700 if received after May 1
- \$50 discount for a rider registering for TWO sessions (2 horses doing 4 total lessons/day)
- \$100 stabling fee for an additional horse for ONE registration
- Auditors: \$25/day or \$75 for duration. Auditing for members of the Area VIII Young Rider and Adult Rider programs, Pony Club and NEOMTA are **FREE**

A **deposit** of \$100 with a completed registration form will hold your spot and lock in the above prices. The full payment is **REQUIRED** by June 30th. **Refunds** only available if can be filled from the waiting list less a \$25 office fee.

### Fees Include:

- Stabling (stalls must be stripped)

### Additional Fees:

- **Meals:** Optional (see proposed menu below)
  - \$90 for all meals

  - \$40 horse & rider massage
  - \$10 rider massage only
